

Photographic Artist

I've been a photographer for as long as I can remember. When I was five I borrowed my dad's camera and took a picture of some pink lupins in the garden. A week later, we got the envelope back from the chemists - yes it was long ago - I could hardly believe the magic, the flowers were alive on the print, but by then, dead in the garden.

I've been taking pictures all my working life; I've never done anything else. I'm using the skills and techniques crafted in my many years as a professional photographer for these new works of art.

My current projects include: The creation of very large - from 2m. to 8m. wide - prints, drawing on nature's poetic reclamation of dry stone walls, which when viewed close up offer a clarity of detail far beyond the normal gaze: A set of similar sized - but vertical - pictures, challenging the conventions of landscape imagery: The Camberwell Beauties project where I've photographed - in extreme close up - some members of my local community, presented as 2m. wide prints: And a more modest-sized series inspired by observing the nuances of Japanese culture through the prism of the elegantly placed bicycles.

Other works include a long-term study of a single, isolated, metropolitan wild cherry tree through the seasons, which led to another series capturing images of solitary semi-urbanised trees presented as 3m. wide prints; and twenty-times magnified, close-up photographs of common or garden flowers, and my latest work, an exploration of epiphytes and bryophytes (lichen and moss), also exhibited on a grand scale.

I've recently been working more loosely, photographing subjects that refuse to be pigeonholed in a neat grouping, under the title Gallimaufry.
